



Grounds Maintenance Technician

Elizabethtown College is seeking a **Grounds Maintenance Technician** to maintain and prepare sports fields for utilization and perform general grounds maintenance duties for the Facilities Management Department.

This position will maintain and prepare sport fields for use; Operation of groomer, aerator, mowers, front end loaders, ride-on spreader and grounds vehicles; Able to work outside in varied weather conditions and be able to perform physical labor; such as raking, snow shoveling, litter removal, and lawn mowing; Additional training will be provided to operate any unfamiliar machinery, such as forklifts, skid-loader and chainsaws, as needed.

High School diploma plus 3 years of grounds experience is required; Experience working with commercial turf maintenance or in a college campus environment is preferred. Special consideration will be given to individuals holding a PA category 07 applicator license. Candidate must acquire a pesticide applicator license within 6 months of hire.

This position requires a valid driver's license for work purposes (individual must have a US driver's license for at least three years; a motor vehicle record check will be run and the incumbent must pass the College's MVR rating system). Additional training will be provided to operate machinery such as front end loaders, forklifts, chippers, and chainsaws as needed.

Hours are Monday-Friday 7:00AM - 3:30PM; occasional overtime associated with snow removal and event preparation.
